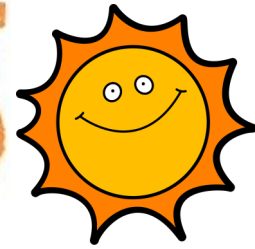

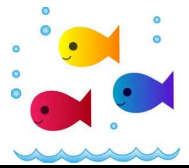

# **Little Learners Summer Camp 2018**

## **GENERAL CAMP INFORMATION**

Camp is held at the DeAnza Park and will be run by Ms. Patricia and her support staff. The facilities at DeAnza Park include air-conditioned rooms to retreat from the summer heat; an age appropriate playground including area for basketball, soccer and other fun sports, covered picnic areas; and a large grass area that's great for playing games or to have picnic lunches. Campers will be in their own area away from the older camp population unless it is nearing the end of the day when they might share outdoor time.

There is a sign in/out sheet at the main camp table which needs to be signed by the person dropping off and picking up the child each day. Payment is due on the first day of attendance if you are signing up for the full week or on a daily basis for those who choose to do camp day-to-day. The children will have the same counselors all summer long to give them consistency.

Camp includes a wide variety of activities that helps ensure your child has many fun experiences. Arts & crafts, water play, sports, games, cooking, science, music and movement and mystery guests are just a few of the activities that are planned throughout the summer. Reinforcement of shapes, colors, writing skills and much more are also part of the program. These activities are done in an age appropriate developmental manner.

**Our program has been specifically developed to meet the different interests and capabilities of your child, while helping them create meaningful relationships with others.**

Frequently Asked Questions:

**Can my child bring a lunch that needs to be refrigerated or warmed up?** Yes. We can refrigerate and warm up food. If your child goes to the pool there is an option to buy lunch and we also will be offering specific hot lunch days at camp.

**What training do the staff/camp teachers have?** The counselors/teachers are all fingerprinted, have CPR and First Aid training and at a minimum have experience in child development. Most of the staff/camp teachers you see during the summer also work at Lupin Hill camp during the school year.

**What if my child has problems with separation?** Our staff will work with you to set a routine for saying goodbye. You are always welcome to call and check in to see how your child is doing at any point during the day.

**What if my child has a food allergy?** Please note this information on the registration paperwork and we will make sure all the staff are aware of your child's allergy and to make sure we don't serve food/items with the allergen. If your child has a prescription for an epipen or directions from your doctor related to care we are more than happy to work with you to ensure your child's medical protocol is followed while in our care.

**We hope you call or email us your questions, concerns and to get more information. Our staff work hard to create a developmentally appropriate fun summer program which your child is sure to enjoy! You are more than welcome to call and check on your child during the camp day and we encourage open communication with all of our participants and their families.**

**RELEASE:** The undersigned is the parent or legal guardian of the minor camper, identified above. In consideration for Little Learners providing to the camper identified above a camp Experience at Camp Calabasas, **I HEREBY, ON MY OWN BEHALF AND ON BEHALF OF THE CAMPER, RELEASE AND DISCHARGE LITTLE LEARNERS, LLC, THE OWNER AND OPERATOR OF CAMP, AND THE CITY OF CALABASAS AND BOTH OF THEIR OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS AND AGENTS (called herein the "Releasees") FOR AND FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS ARISING OUT OF THE CAMPER'S PARTICIPATION IN THE CAMP, INCLUDING CLAIMS ARISING OUT OF THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR ANY OTHER CAMPER THAT CAUSES, OR IS CLAIMED TO CAUSE, INJURY OR DEATH TO THE CAMPER IDENTIFIED ABOVE, PROPERTY DAMAGE, OR OTHER DAMAGES. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I understand and acknowledge that participation in camp activities involves risk of injury. I fully appreciate the risks involved in my camper's participation in these activities and voluntarily assume, on the camper's behalf, those risks.

**PROMISE TO DEFEND, IDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS:** In consideration of the above camper being permitted to participate in Little Learners camp, **I agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless** the Releasees from and against all claims arising out of the camper's participation in the camp.

**LITTLE LEARNERS AGES 4-6 SUMMER CAMP 2018**  
**Important Information and Admission Agreement**

- Registration:** There are four easy ways to register. You can mail-in, walk-in or fax-in email or drop off the registration form. **Payments are to be made out to Little Learners. THERE IS A \$25 REGISTRATION FEE DUE ON YOUR CHILD'S FIRST DAY OF ATTENDANCE.**  
Fees include all activities, special events, morning and afternoon snack.
- Camp Times:** \*Camp Calabasas activities are scheduled from 9:00am to Noon daily for part time attendees.  
\*Full Day participants get extended care is offered in the morning from 7:00am to 9:00am and from 4:00pm to 6:30pm which is included in the price. If your child attends anytime before 9am and stays after Noon the cost of camp will be the full day rate. There is a discount if you sign up for the full day for the full week when you drop off on Monday. Parents running late will be charged \$1.00/minute and it must be paid to the supervising staff member, for every minute that you are late.
- Camp Dress:** \*Campers are required to wear closed-toe shoes each day they attend camp.  
\***Crock style shoes are permitted as long as the toes are closed. Campers with open toes shoes will be sent home or must have a pair of closed toe shoes brought to them at camp.**  
**REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN IF YOUR CHILD IS SENT HOME FOR WEARING THE WRONG TYPE OF SHOES!**  
\*Additional/Replacement camp field trip shirts are available for \$15.00.
- What to Bring:** \*Campers should bring a sack lunch with a drink each day even if doing half day as we eat at 11:30am. We recommend putting sunscreen on your child prior to them arriving at camp and we will reapply.  
**\*LABEL ALL BELONGINGS WITH A PERMANENT MARKER\***
- Water Play** Campers will have the opportunity to play with water (pool, water balloons, water table, water sprayers, etc.). Please pack an extra set of clothes for your child even if they don't stay the full day.
- Dismissal Policy:** Expulsion from the Camp Calabasas and Little Learners Program results from one or more of the following situations:  
(1) Physically or verbally abusing another participant or staff member, (2) Refusal to correct documented problematic behavior, (3) Theft, (4) Parent Payment Negligence, (5) Excessive Late Pick-Ups
- Discipline:** We strive to provide a well-rounded and safe program for all participants. Discipline will be handled in the following manner and depending on the infraction might vary:  
(1) Child will be spoken to and/or redirected to another activity  
(2) Child will be sent home/suspended from the program  
(3) A written report will be completed by the staff and a meeting will be set up with the parents/guardians
- Sign In/Out:** Children arriving and departing camp must be signed in and out on a daily basis. **Parents or those authorized to pick up your child must sign them out before leaving at the end of the day. Dropping your child off to walk into camp is not authorized. If your child is not signed into camp you will be called to pick them up.** Adding additional authorized persons to pick up needs to be done in writing or via the email that you have on file with camp. PHOTO IDENTIFICATION will be requested upon picking up.
- Snack:** Camp will provide a morning and afternoon snack for all campers. Children may also bring snacks for the morning and afternoon. If your child has a food allergy or condition please make sure to mark it on the paperwork. You may also provide your own snack.
- Lost Items:** These items will be kept for 2 weeks and then donated to a local collection center. Please check for goods left behind as soon as you realize they are missing. Also, please don't take things that you see and might belong to someone else as they might return for their items.

## Important Information and Admission Agreement

**Payments:** \*All payments to Little Learners must be made by credit card, checks to be payable to Little Learners, money order or cash. We will process checks via EFT with the signed form attached to this packet. Payments will be run on the Friday prior to the start of each session.  
\*All returned to us for NSF or any other reason will be required to be replaced with cash or a credit card. If there are any problems collecting the owed money for returned checks the information will be turned over to the District Attorneys Check Restitution program. A fee of \$25 will also be charged for any returned check.

**Refunds:** All refunds and cancellations of days must have **FIVE BUSINESS DAYS NOTICE** emailed to us at **campcalabasas@gmail.com** prior to the session start date in order to avoid being charged. Excessive changes will result in an administrative fee of \$15.00 per hour.

**There will be no refunds or transfers due to illness or non-attendance for registered days as we pre-schedule and plan based on our pre-registrations and know how many drop in's we can accept on a daily basis.**

You are financially responsible for all days registered unless we are notified via email or in writing within the required time period about such changes. If you email us we will respond letting you know we received your notice. If you do not get a reply please assume we did not get your message. All staff who take the registration forms, answer calls and interact with parents know these policies and will not take a phone message for such changes as an email must be sent. For those who **do not** register in advance please be advised that we might not have spots for all of the drop-in's. If you know your child wants to attend specific trip you must pre-pay to hold your spot. If you do not tell us on Monday that your child will be attending full time then you will be charged the daily rate and won't get the full time attendance price break.

**Discipline:** We strive to provide a well-rounded and safe program for all participants. Discipline will be handled in the following manner and depending on the infraction:  
(1) Child will be spoken to and/or redirected to another activity (2) Child will be suspended from the program (3) A written report will be completed by the staff and a meeting will be set up with the parent to discuss an appropriate outcome.  
**<Children causing harm to another participant or any of our camp staff will be immediately dismissed from our program. In addition any child with three warnings will be asked to leave the program.>**

**Medications:** If your child is taking a prescription medicine we have a form that you can fill out for us to assist in giving them doses while your child is at camp. If your child is taking an over the counter medicine we can give that medicine with a form filled out and must follow the dosing instructions on the bottle.

**Illness:** If the child comes to the program and becomes ill his parent/guardian is called to pick up the child. The sick child will be isolated from the other children until picked up by the parent/guardian. If the child has a fever, stomach or intestinal illness, they will not be allowed back to the program until 24 hours after the condition has passed.

**Injury:** In case of injury, the staff shall give appropriate first aid to the child. If it is the judgment of the staff that the injury is an emergency, paramedics will be called to the site and a parent or guardian shall be contacted.

**Activity Plans:** Weekly activity plans will be available to each registrant. These plans will show what activities we are doing in camp as well as notifying you of the times we leave for field trips and arrive back at the park.

Swimming and/or water related activities are one of the optional activities available to campers enrolled in our summer camp programs. Certain field trips (dependent on age group) also include outings to water parks and the beach. Each location has lifeguards and/or other safety personnel on duty provided by the facilities. Example facilities include but are not limited to: the Calabasas Tennis and Swim Center, Lake Casitas Water Park, Soak City Water Park, Hurricane Harbor Water Park, Raging Waters, LA County Beaches and in water play during campers' time at DeAnza Park.

Before the child of whom you are the parent/guardian can participate in these types of field trips involving swimming and/or water related activities, you, the parent/guardian, must complete and sign this Summer 2018 Field Trip Permission Slip & Waiver and Release. This form must be completed, signed, and returned to Little Learners before the day of the field trip. Failure to complete this form before the day of the field trip, will result in the child of whom you are the parent/guardian to remain onsite at camp where they will join a group close to his/her age for an alternate activity if that is an option/or else they will need to be picked up before such excursions.

**WAIVER AND RELEASE**
